Stop, think, look, listen



Stop at the kerb. Think what to do next. Look both ways to check for traffic. Listen for traffic noise. When the road is clear and you can't hear any traffic coming you can cross.

Lollipop crossing



Wait until the Lollipop person says it is safe to cross. Keep looking as you cross.

Traffic lights



Press the button and wait for the green man to show. When the green man shows and the traffic has stopped you can cross the road.

Crossing on a hill



Move to a safer place where you can see the traffic coming from all directions.

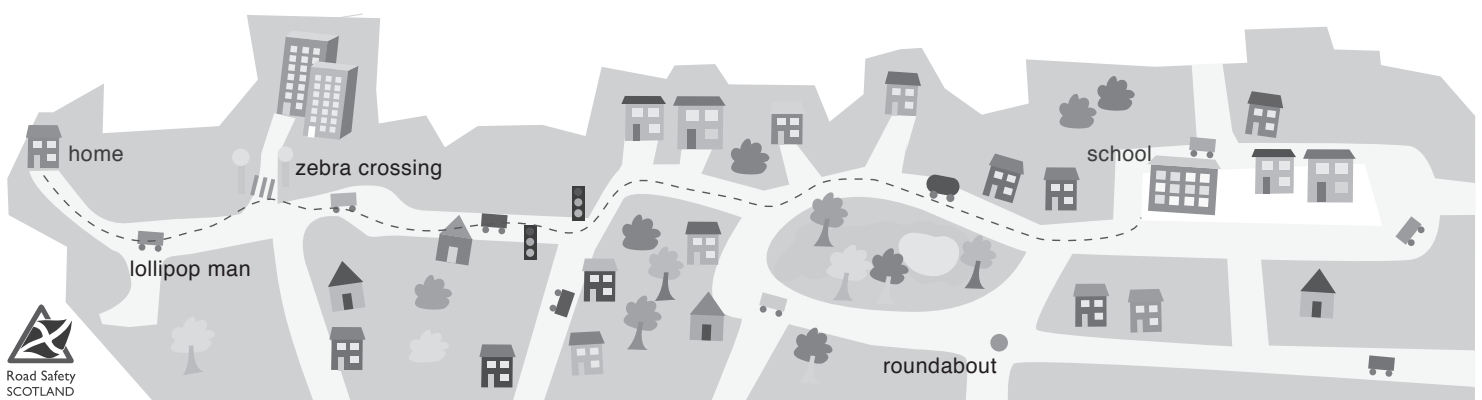
Zebra crossing



Stop on the kerb. Think what to do next. Look both ways to check the road is clear. Listen for traffic noise. When the road is clear and you can't hear any traffic coming you can cross.

Next steps

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Lollipop crossing



Even after the lollipop person gives you a signal to cross check that it is safe before stepping off the kerb.

Traffic lights



When the red man is showing it is a signal to stay on the pavement.

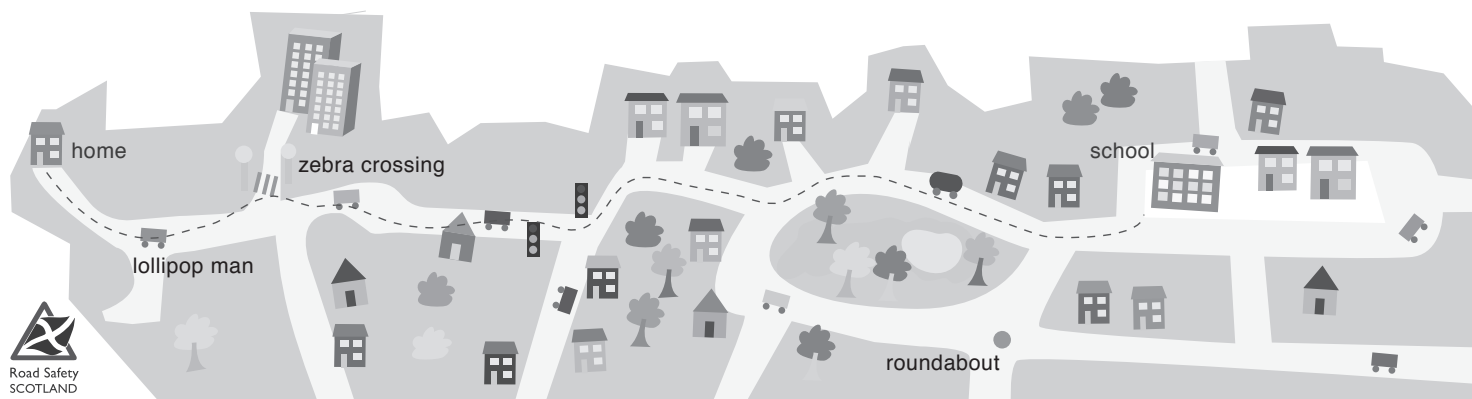
Crossing at the school gate



There might be distractions at the school gate. Make sure you concentrate and take your time before you cross the road.

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Being seen



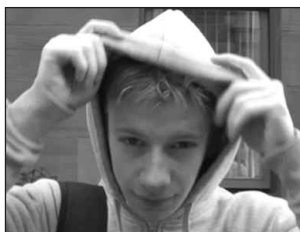
Make sure that you wear something bright so that traffic can see you.

Think for yourself



Another person might cross the road without looking. Do not follow them. You should use your own judgement before you cross the road.

Seeing clearly



If you have your hood up take it down before you cross the road so that you can see and hear clearly.

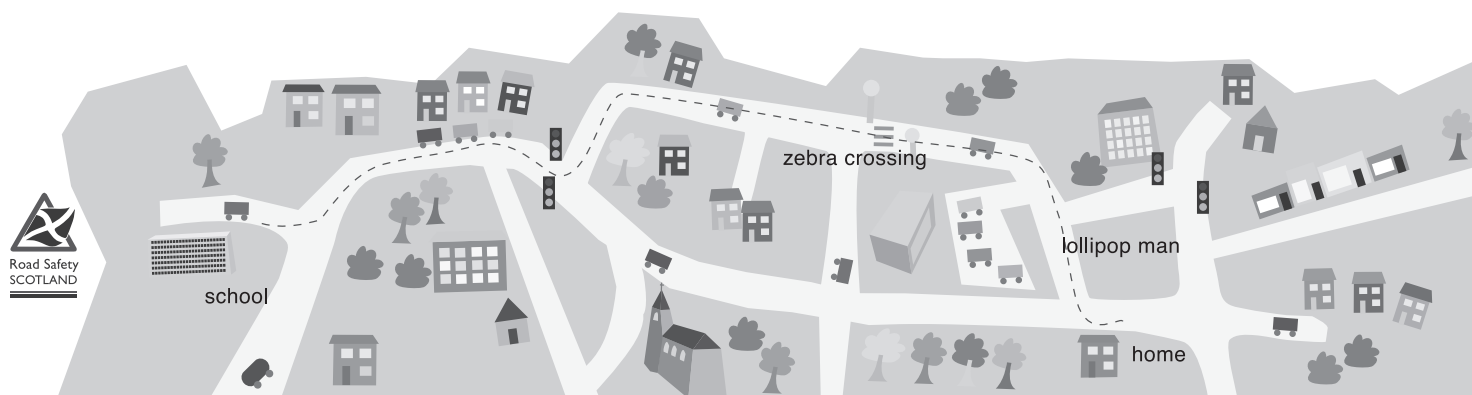
Crossing between parked cars



On a quiet road with parked cars make sure you stand where the drivers can see you clearly.

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Crossing on a hill



Always avoid crossing on a hill. Find a safer place.

Reversing car



Look for clues to see if a car is reversing. Stop, think, look and listen.

Crossing between parked cars



This is not the best place to cross but sometimes you can. Stand where drivers can see you clearly.

Road barriers



Railings and barriers along the pavement are there to keep you safe. Never be tempted to jump over them even to see a friend.

Lollipop crossing



Always walk in front of the lollipop person when you get the signal to cross

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
