Driving for Work – what's the risk

- On average 1 in 3 collisions involve someone who is driving for work
- Most occupations involve some element of driving
- Driving for work is a big risk
- 'normal' Health and Safety Legislation doesn't recognise driving

- survey of ScORSA workshop participants

- x2 facilitated discussion groups with ScORSA members



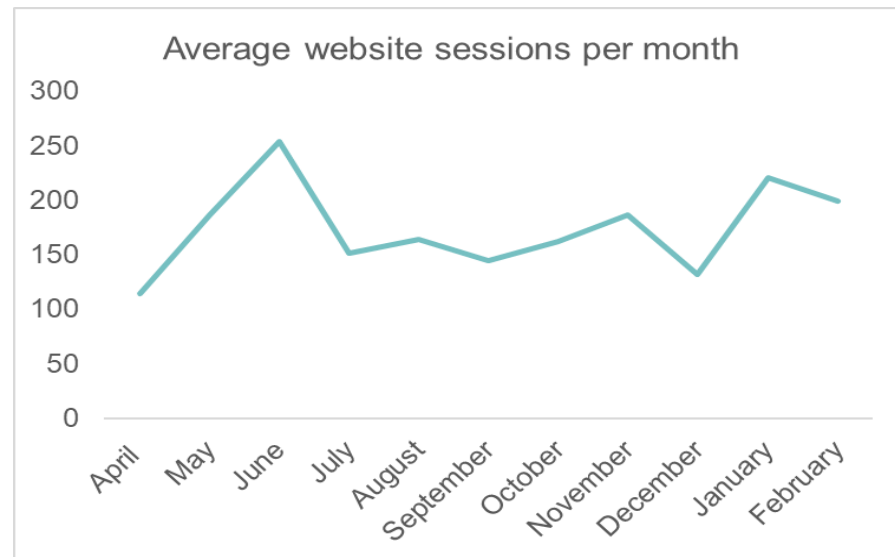
Project Delivery

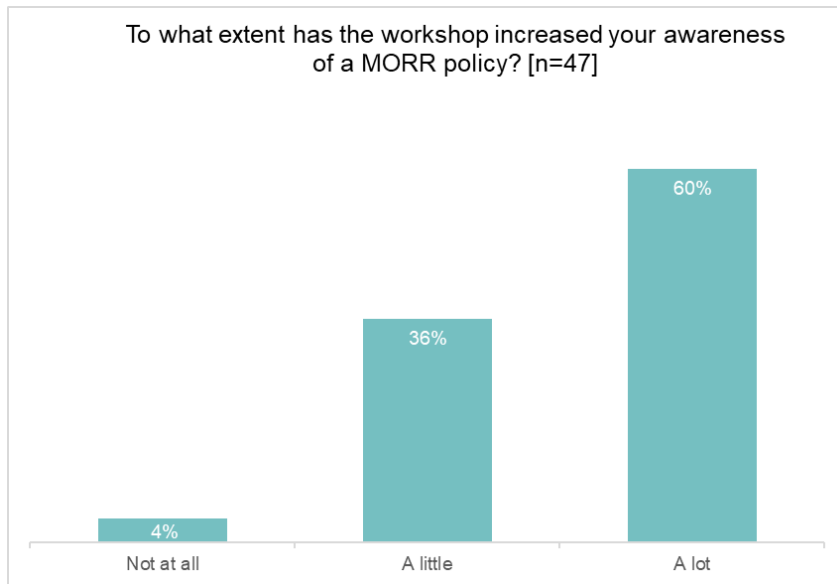

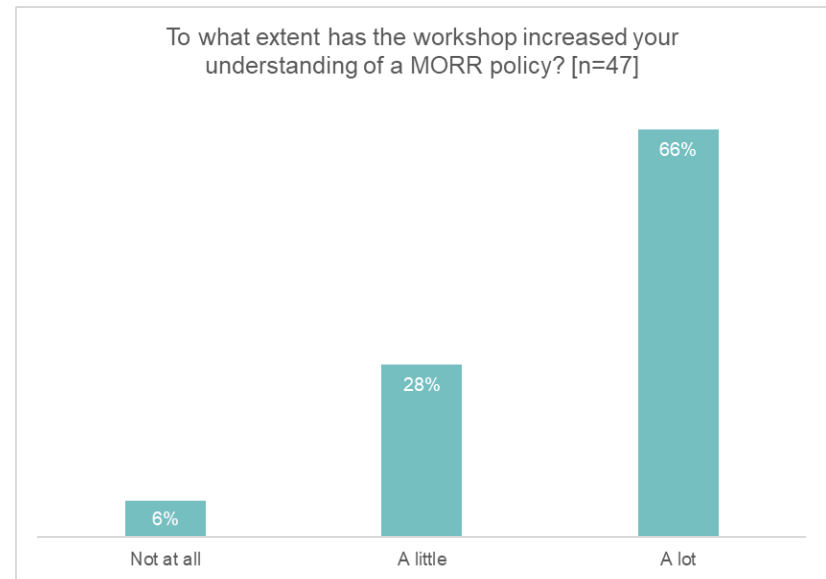


Outcomes achieved
