WHAT IS THE SPEED CAMPAIGN?

1 in 5 deaths on Scotland's roads are caused by speeding.

The Scottish Government is tackling the serious issue of speeding with a road safety campaign, asking drivers to slow down to help reduce collisions and casualties.

No matter how experienced you are as a driver, a collision can happen to anyone, and the consequences could be devastating. The campaign delivers a strong message to drivers – you only have to lose control once.

In this toolkit you will find more information and key messages to help you share the campaign wider, example social media posts for your own channels, and links to access campaign assets.

KEY MESSAGES

1 in 5 deaths on Scotland's roads are caused by speeding.

Reducing your speed means reducing your chances of a serious collision.

Just 5mph slower could save a life. When drivers reduce their speed from 65mph to 60mph, fatal collisions are cut in half.¹

A collision could happen to anyone - no matter how good a driver you think you are. You only have to lose control once.

Last year, nearly two thirds of people killed on Scotland's roads died on rural routes, where higher speeds make crashes far more serious, despite these roads accounting for 42% of all road casualties.

If you're caught speeding you could face a £100 fine and 3 penalty points added to your license.
